

RAINBOW

We Indians should be proud of being born in India, a spiritually oriented country, which was called as "a country of snakes" by British. Yes, in India we worship serpents, temples are exclusively for Naga Raja seen in India. Lord Vishnu's anantha sayanam is on five headed cobra. Lord Shiva is decorated with Naga serpent around his neck. Every year, Hindus celebrate Naga panchami. Ladies offer milk and conduct poojas to serpents, residing in ant-hill. When Vasudeva and infant Krishna were crossing the river in torrential rain to reach Gokulam, Adhi Sesha with his hood gave full protection for Vasudeva and infant Krishna.

In India, Hindus worship planets as Devathas. Best example is, we do Surya namaskar at dawn every day. Poojas are performed to propitiate Sun God. Agni hothra is performed in most of the houses. MOOLADHARA	RED






Now, look at the human body -According to our ancient science. It has an invisible energy body (bio magnetic field, aura), in the form of zero. (Of
